FOR YOUR SAFETY

ALL HANDLERS AND GALLERY MEMBERS MUST WEAR AN ARTICLE OF BLAZE ORANGE. NO EXCEPTIONS! These events do require the use of dogs and horses. The hunt test committee can not guarantee the disposition of these animals. We ask that parents do not allow their children to approach the dogs and horses while they are tied out, without permission. We don't want anyone to be bitten, kicked, stepped on, wrapped up in chains, or hurt in any way.

HUNTING TEST EXPECTATIONS

AMATEUR WALKING PUPPY STAKE — For dogs 6 months and under 15 months of age. Dogs born before January 29, 2022 are not eligible for this stake. Puppies must show a desire to hunt, boldness and initiative in covering ground and searching likely cover. They should indicate the presence of game if the opportunity is presented. Puppies should show reasonable obedience to their handlers command, but should not be given additional credit for pointing staunchly. Each dog should be judged on its actual performance as indicating its future as a high class bird dog. Bitches in season will NOT be allowed to run in the puppy stake. No blank pistols are to be fired in this stake. No birds will be released. Dogs with FSS or PAL registration aren't eligible for AWP

JUNIOR HUNTING TEST — A junior dog must show a keen desire to hunt, be bold and independent, have a fast yet attractive manner of hunting and demonstrate not only intelligence in seeking objectives, but also the ability to find game. A junior dog must establish point, but no additional credit shall be given for steadiness to wing and shot. If the handler is in reasonable gun range of a bird which has been flushed after a point, a blank cartridge must be fired by the handler. Junior dogs must hold point until the handler gets within normal gunshot range. Junior dogs must also show reasonable obedience to their handler's commands. A "flash" point cannot be graded as pointing. A dog may be restrained (collared) to prevent interference with the dog on point.

SENIOR HUNTING TEST — Senior dogs must show all the attributes of a junior dog. In addition the dog must be steady to wing and must remain in position until the bird is shot or they are released. A senior dog must retrieve, but need not deliver to hand. Whenever it encounters its bracemate on point, it must honor, but may be given a verbal command to do so. A senior dog must acknowledge that its bracemate is on point before it is cautioned to honor. A senior dog must stop on a wild flush, but may be given a verbal command to do so. If a senior dog does not have the opportunity to demonstrate its ability to retrieve or honor during the running of the brace, it will be called back to demonstrate these abilities, provided the dog is in a position to receive a qualifying score. Senior dogs which render a bird unfit for the table or which steals their bracemate's point will not receive a qualifying score.

MASTER HUNTING TEST — Master Hunting dogs must give a finished performance and demonstrate clearly that it deserves to be qualified as such This is the complete hunting companion that any hunter would be proud to own. It must be under its handler's control at all times, and handle kindly with a minimum of noise and hacking by the handler. A master hunting dog must show a keen desire to hunt. The dog must hunt for it's handler at all times at a range suitable for a handler on foot, and should show or check in front of its handler frequently. It must cover adequate ground but never range out of sight for a length of time that would detract from its usefulness as a practical hunting companion. The dog must locate game, must point staunchly, and must be steady to wing and shot on all birds, and if it breaks it cannot receive a qualifying score. Intelligent use of the wind and terrain in locating game, accurate nose and intensity on point ar essential. Whenever it encounters a bracemate on point, it must honor. A dog that steals its bracemate's point cannot receive a qualifying score. A master hunting dog must positively demonstrate its steadiness to wing and shot. The handler shall not command or signal the dog to retrieve until positive steadiness has been demonstrated. The dog must retrieve promptly, tenderly and absolutely to hand.

JUDGES

Judges' decisions are final. Once a dog comes to the line, the judge has complete control over dogs and handlers. Judges shall have the authority to disqualify a dog that is not present within five (5) minutes after it has been called to run by the judges. A person may not agree with judges' decision, but he/she cannot confront the judge, other than to politely ask why the dog did not qualify. Any rudeness on the part of the handler is subject to disciplinary action. Judges are not obliged to discuss scores with handlers, but if they elect to do so, such discussions shall only be held after the completion of the test. A handler can complain to the Hunting Test Committee and write to the AKC, but he/she should not confront the judge. The Hunting Test Committee will take action regarding such situations at the conclusion of the stake.

BITCHES IN SEASON

Bitches in season will NOT be allowed to run.

SAFETY

All handlers, gunners, marshalls, judges and gallery participants for all test levels are required to wear an upper outer article of blaze orange. Eye protection is strongly recommended for all handlers, judges and gunners in Master and Senior Hunting Tests. Hearing protection is strongly recommended in all tests.

A Break Action (SxS, O/U, Single Shot) shotgun must be carried by Master Hunt Test Handlers. NO pump action, bolt action or semi-automatic shotguns are permitted.

Blank/Starter Pistols: Must be carried by all handlers in all Hunt test levels during their brace. Pistols are NOT to be used in the Amateur Walking Puppy Stake.

FOOD, WATER, RESTROOMS

Lunches will be available on grounds. Drinking water is available on grounds, but please remember to bring plenty of water for your dogs. Portable restrooms are available on site.

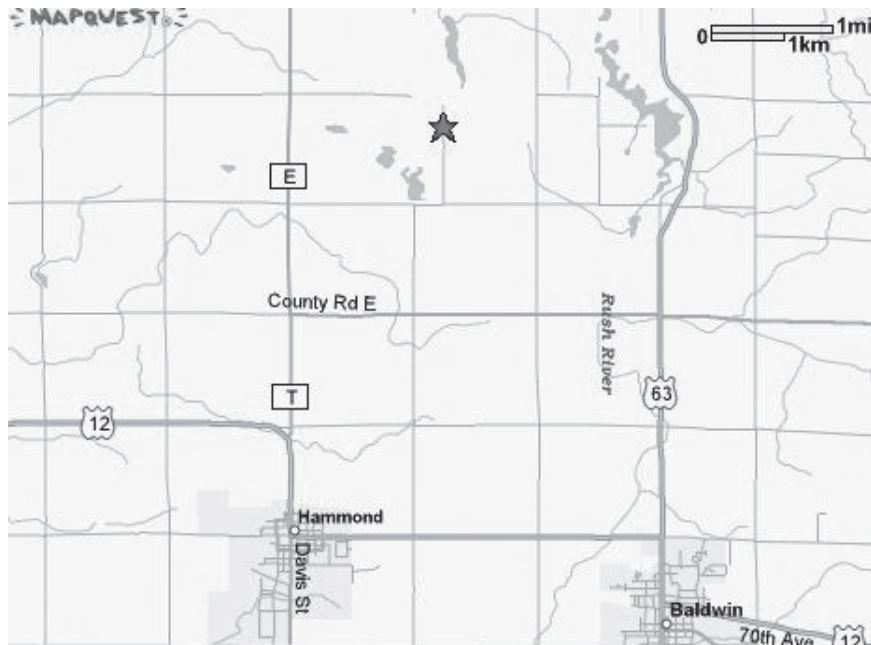
SCRATCH POLICY

Stay to the right on County Road T (just past the Hammond Golf Course) 2.1 miles, to 110 th. Avenue, turn Right on 110 th. Avenue go 1.0 miles, turn left to stay on 110 th. Ave., 0.2 miles, Turn Left on 192 nd. St. 0.8 miles. Hunt tests will be at the end of the dead end road. Look for signs that will direct you to the appropriate field for the tests.
